

  - o Through networking and advice
  - o By signing up for one of our paired 1:1 Cross Campus mentorship programs
  - o Through an online discussion board to ask questions of fellow Cross Campus users
  - By joining or creating one or more of the 40 groups on Cross Campus
- Cross Campus extends our campus community beyond New Haven and bolsters the alumni experience by harnessing the power of our Yale community.
- Cross Campus members can:
  - o Give back and share all they have learned with the next generation of Yalies.
